### AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### **What is the current enrollment?**

Approximately 150 undergraduate students are enrolled in OSU's agricultural education program. Some students have double majors, which are available in animal science, agricultural economics and horticulture.

#### **What is the salary of a beginning agricultural education teacher?**

The minimum starting salary for Oklahoma agriculture teachers in the 2009-2010 school year is approximately \$40,320. That figure is expected to increase during the next several years. Salaries in other states will vary with the community and location.

#### **What can I do if I decide not to teach?**

Agricultural education graduates also take jobs in corporate agriculture, extension, sales or banking. Agricultural education graduates are prepared for a wide variety of jobs in the agriculture industry because they have a broad base of knowledge, combined with excellent people skills.
